

Bull Terrier Club Of Dallas Temporary Care (Foster Home) Release Form

1. The Bull Terrier Club of Dallas (hereafter known as BTCD) and the Bull Terrier Club of America (hereafter known as BTCA) and its Directors, Officers and Members shall not be responsible for any damage or injury to any person or property caused by this Bull Terrier while in temporary care. (Temporary care refers to an animal placed in a private home for the purpose of providing shelter until a permanent home has been found). The BTCD has explained the Bull Terrier's behavior and medical history to the undersigned to the best of their knowledge. The undersigned is aware there are no guarantees, warranty, or full knowledge of this Bull Terrier's health and temperament. Undersigned volunteers to accept said dog to their charge as a humanitarian act and agrees to release and hold harmless the BTCD and BTCA from any and all liability or responsibility in connection with fostering this Bull Terrier.
2. The undersigned who is providing temporary care for the animal does not legally own the animal. Ownership is transferred only when an adoption agreement has been signed and on record and an adoption fee has been received.
3. The undersigned understands that in normal circumstances no reimbursement will be made for normal care and feeding and agrees to pay for the animal's food while in temporary care. If the foster home is in need of assistance with food or a crate for the dog, this can be arranged by contacting the BTCD rescue chairperson. The BTCD must approve any reimbursable medical or other expenses beyond normal care in advance. Any approved reimbursable expenses must be accompanied by the original receipts and submitted to your BTCD rescue coordinator or rescue chair.
4. The undersigned agrees to care for this Bull Terrier in a responsible manner providing proper food, shelter and medical care as needed, and will restrain this pet appropriately at all times keeping the dog on a leash or in a fenced-in yard. Under no circumstances is the Bull Terrier to be allowed to run in a Dog Park.
5. It is the hope of the BTCD that the undersigned keep the foster Bull Terrier in their care until a permanent home is found giving the BTCD enough time to evaluate the dog in a settled environment. The undersigned has the right to terminate the temporary care arrangement at any time, he/she must notify the BTCD rescue coordinator by telephone 72 hours in advance.
6. The BTCD has the right to request that the animal be returned at any time. The BTCD also has the right to refuse adoption.

BTCD MAKES NO WARRANTIES OR CLAIMS TO THE HEALTH OR TEMPERAMENT OF THIS BULL TERRIER.

I/we acknowledge that I have reviewed this Temporary Care Release form. I/we understand and accept its terms and accept full responsibility for the dog and its actions while in my/our foster care.
